A shared long-term vision of what we can accomplish together will assure New Athens CUSD 60 schools remain the finest in the area.

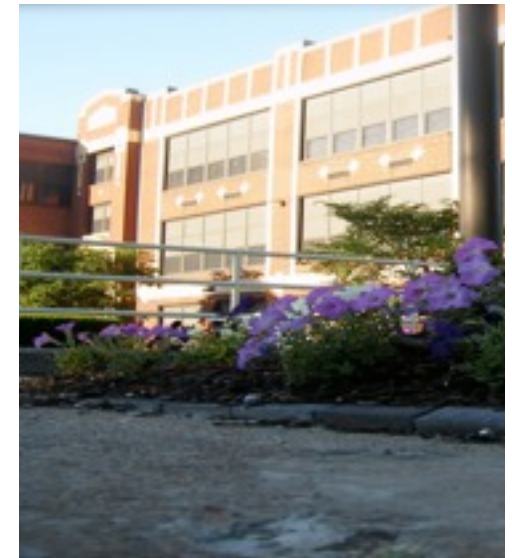
