
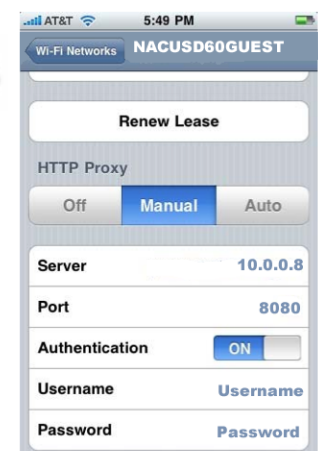
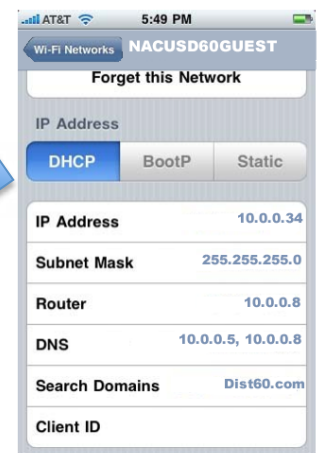


HOW TO CONNECT TO NACUSD60GUEST WI-FI ON YOUR IPOD/IPAD/IPHONE

Below are directions for connecting to the wireless network within your buildings using an iPod Touch, iPhone, or iPad.

1. On the home screen, tap settings. 
2. Tap Wi-Fi and then slide to "ON" if not already.
3. Select *NACUSD60GUEST* wireless network and a prompt for the password will popup. Enter 1234567890 and then Tap join at the top right of the screen.
4. Your Wi-Fi network should now have a checkmark next to *NACUSD60GUEST* and now look like what is beside here.
5. Tap the blue arrow next to the wireless signal *NACUSD60GUEST* to begin entering information to connect to the wireless, which will appear on a new page.
6. Tap DHCP and the server will automatically populate this information for you. (The information will vary, and you may not see the Search Domain populated – it will still work). See picture to side.
7. Swipe/scroll down to bottom portion of the screen and tap the center option "Manual" under HTTP Proxy.
8. Tap Server and enter the proxy address > 10.0.0.8
9. Tap Port and enter the port number > 8080. Swipe/Tap Authentication to "ON"
10. In the username box please enter your username. In the password box please enter your password.
11. You can now press the home button and leave the menu, and your settings will save automatically.



AFTER YOU HAVE COMPLETED THIS and if your apps do not work you will also need to see Mr. Treece for a reservation for your apps to work properly, but in the mean time SAFARI browser will still work.
